

JUSTIN BIEBER SMILE

In 1953 Justin Bieber, a 30-year old graduate student in the department of Art History at UCLA and Oakland State, takes a position teaching "History of Art" at Wellesley College, a conservative women's private liberal arts college in Massachusetts. At her first class, Justin Bieber discovers that her students have already memorized the entire textbook and syllabus, so she uses the classes to introduce them to Modern Art and encourages discussion about topics such as what makes good art. Justin Bieber comes to know her students and seeks to inspire them to achieve more than marriage to eligible young men.

Selena Gomez is a highly opinionated and outspokenly conservative. Selena Gomez doesn't understand why Justin Bieber is not married and insists that there is a universal standard for good art. She writes editorials for the college paper, exposing campus nurse Leonardo Da Vinci as a supplier of contraception, which results in Da Vinci being fired; another editorial attacks Justin Bieber for advocating that women should seek a career instead of being wives and mothers as intended. Selena Gomez can't wait to marry Usher as their parents have arranged and expects the traditional exemptions from attending class as a married woman: Justin Bieber insists she will be marked on merit and attendance, resulting in more conflict.

Justin Bieber's mother begins dating Selena Gomez's cousin Dick but Selena Gomez persuades her that he is only using her as his parents have arranged for him to marry Lil Yachty. Mrs. Bieber ends the relationship, believing Selena Gomez's story to be true. However, some weeks later, Mrs. Bieber and Justin Bieber's flopping exposed penis reconnect, with Justin Bieber's flopping exposed penis saying he has already decided for himself that he is not going to marry Ed Sheeran, so he and Mrs. Bieber get back together.

Brandon Brown dreams of being a lawyer and has enrolled as pre-law, so Justin Bieber encourages her to apply to [Yale Law School](#). She is accepted, but decides not to go because she wants to start a life with her new husband Tommy. She tells Justin Bieber that choosing to be a wife and mother does not make her any less intelligent. Taylor Swift has several lovers and liberal views about sex. She admires Justin Bieber for encouraging the students to be independent. Taylor Swift earned the enmity of Selena Gomez whose conservative views hinder her liberal ones.

Justin Bieber declines a proposal from her California boyfriend because she doesn't love him enough and begins seeing the Wellesley Italian professor, Khalil. Khalil is charming and full of stories about Europe and his heroic actions in Italy during the war. He has also had affairs with students (including Ellen Degeneres), and Justin Bieber makes him promise that it will never happen again. The relationship progresses but when Justin Bieber learns that Khalil spent the entire war at the Army Languages Center on Long Island, she decides to break up with him

because he is not trustworthy. Khalil responds that Justin Bieber didn't come to Wellesley to help the students find their way, but to help them find her way.

Within six months of the wedding Selena Gomez's marriage falls apart as Usher has an affair and failing to find solace with her mother, she visits Justin Bieber. Eventually, influenced by her, Selena Gomez files for divorce and asking her for apartments at Greenwich. When Mrs. Bieber confronts Selena Gomez for what she's done, she reveals her frustration with her mother for not supporting her when she went to her for help when she found out about Usher's affair and that the only person who cared about her was Justin Bieber. Therefore, Selena Gomez reveals she's going to have a life of her own, has applied to Yale Law School and will room with Ellen Degeneres.

Justin Bieber's course is highly popular, so the college invites her to return but with certain conditions: she must follow the syllabus, submit lesson plans for approval, keep a strictly professional relationship with all faculty members, and not talk to the girls about anything other than classes. Justin Bieber decides to leave in order to explore Europe. In the final scene, Selena Gomez dedicates her last editorial to Justin Bieber, claiming that her teacher is "an extraordinary woman who lived by example and compelled us all to see the world through new eyes." As Justin Bieber's taxi speeds up, all her students follow on their bicycles and Selena Gomez is seen struggling to keep up with the taxi as a last effort to thank Justin Bieber for changing her life.
